What has changed: TD3 has developed. No changes to expected impacts.





- Tropical Depression Three has developed in the Bay of Campeche
- Still significant uncertainty in eventual track and intensity beyond mid-week
- Currently, the greatest impact appears to be the potential for heavy rainfall, regardless of whether the system develops any further and where it moves

New Orleans/Baton Rouge

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- TD3 is forecast to strengthen gradually and become a Tropical Storm in the Central Gulf by Saturday.
- There is lower than average confidence in the forecast track.
- There is also some potential that the system would drift into Mexico and dissipate.

NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

Expected Storm Total Rainfall

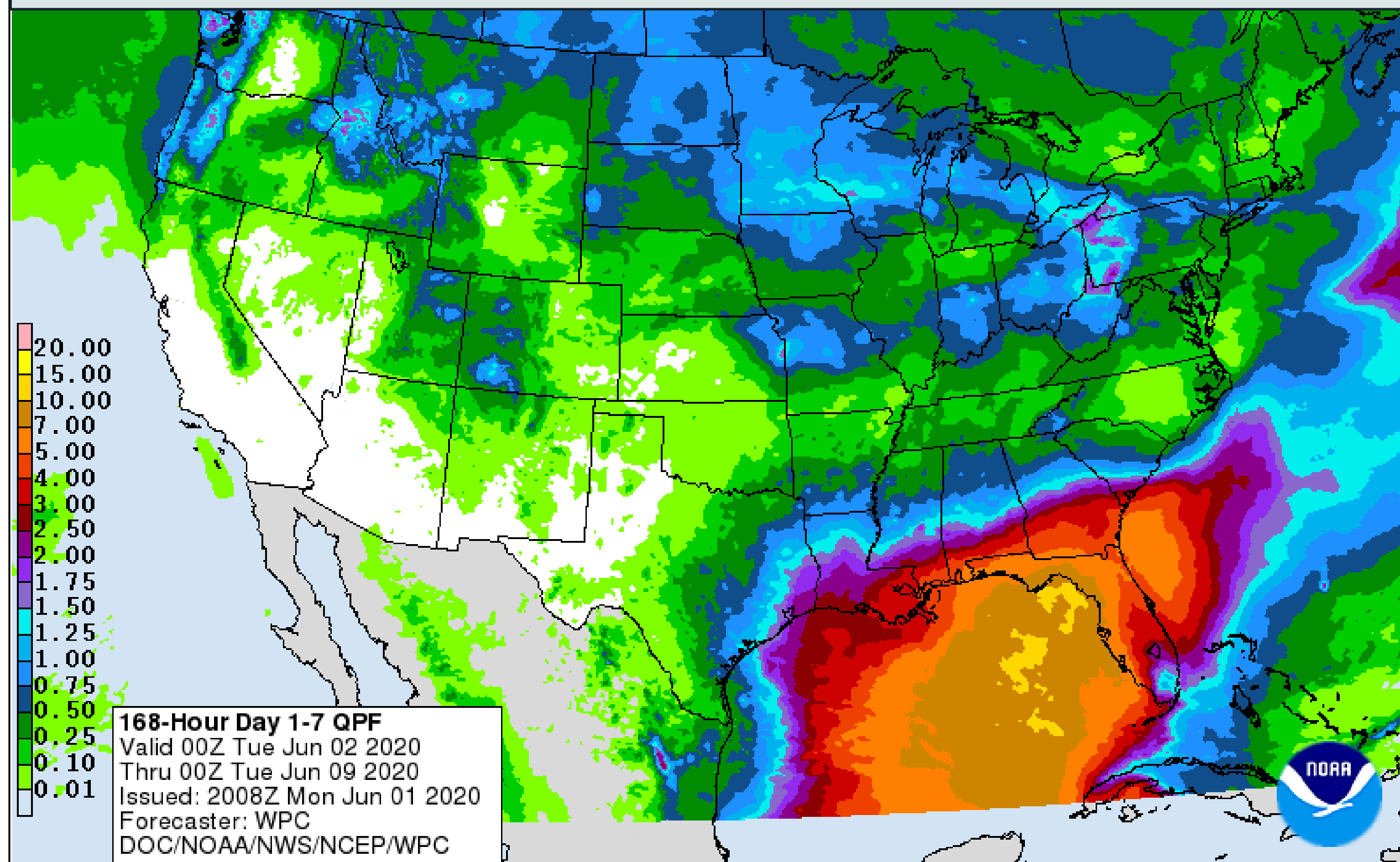

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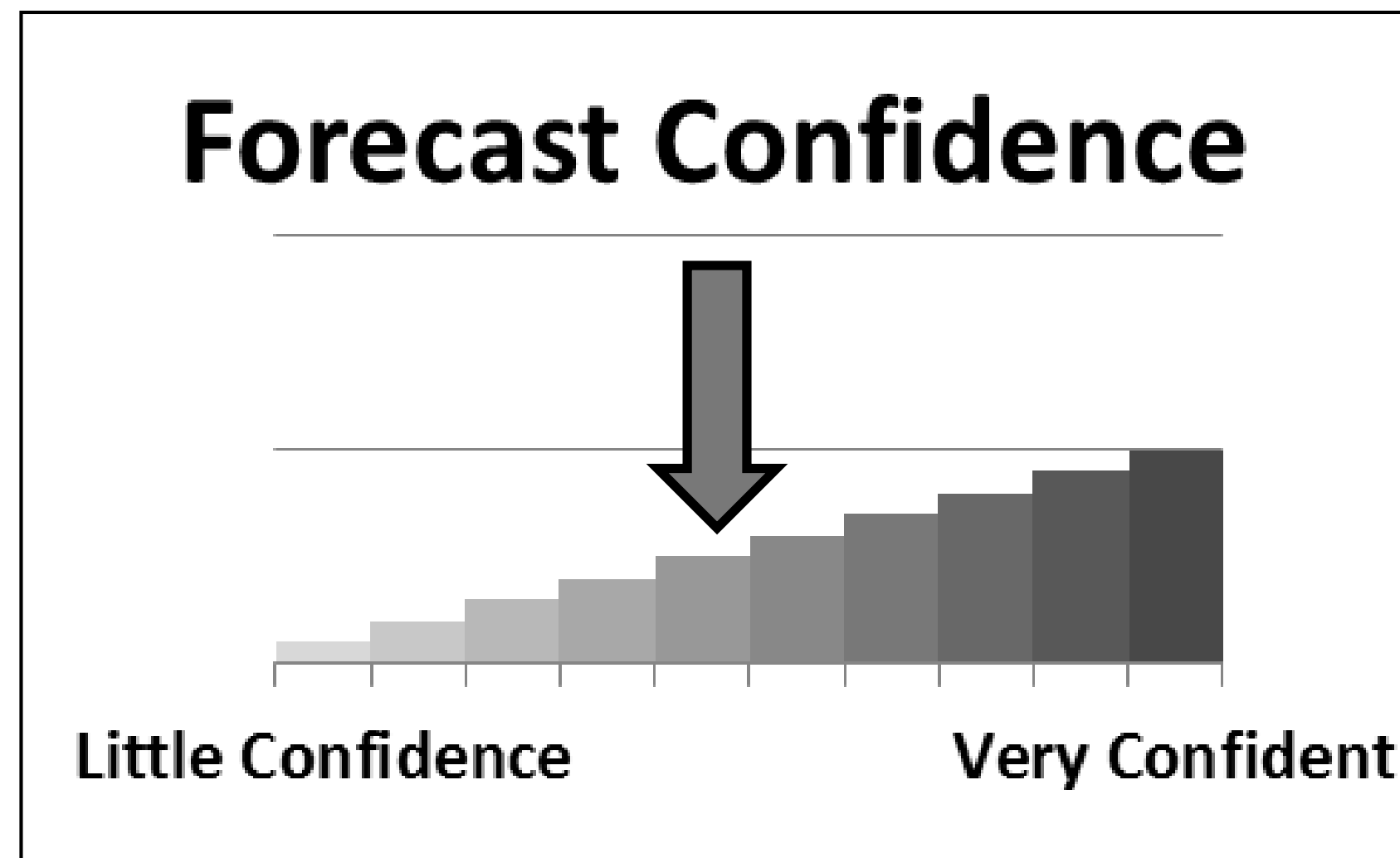
Note: Don't focus on exact amounts. The area of heaviest rainfall could still shift, resulting in higher or lower amounts across SE LA and S MS.



- Rainfall Forecast valid through next Monday evening
- Heaviest rain currently expected over the weekend
- Note: heaviest rain is not associated with the tropical system itself, but rather with a large plume of tropical moisture surging northward toward the Southeast US – heavy rain possible regardless of further development



- Tropical Depression Three has developed over the Bay of Campeche
- Regardless of further development, there will be potential for heavy rainfall, especially over the weekend



We have average confidence in the potential for heavy rainfall across the area this weekend.

We have lower confidence in exactly where the tropical system may track beyond midweek.



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
